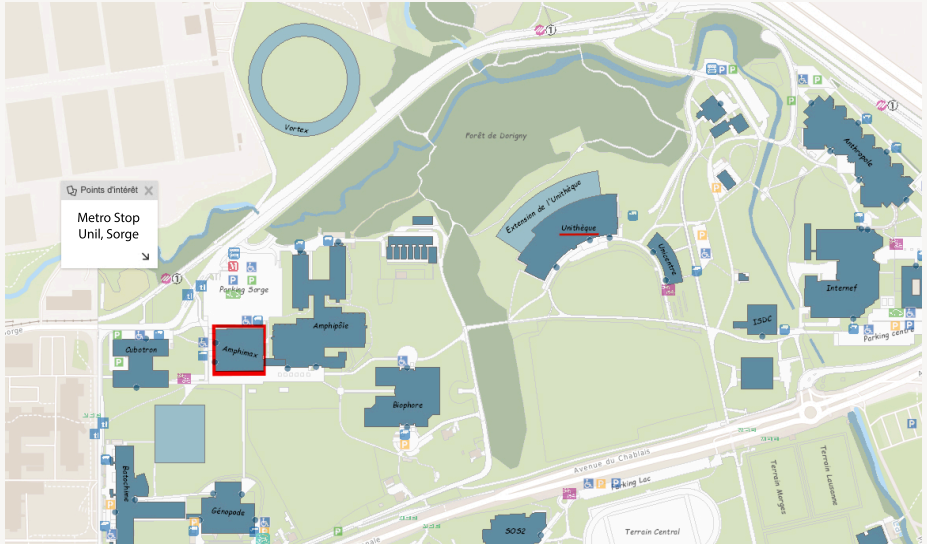

Lausanne Gare, Metro M2 --> Lausanne Flon

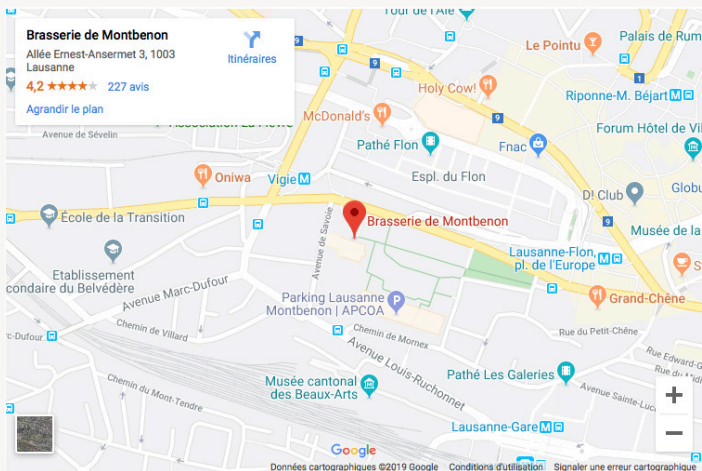
Lausanne Flon, Metro M1 --> UniL Sorge

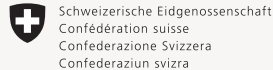
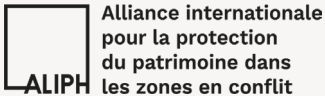
